Description:

My Personal Touch Land Services is seeking five (5) Lawn and Landscape workers to work during the period April 1, 2026 - December 31, 2026. The position is seasonal and full-time. The main worksite is located at 18 Sandstone Road, Eldon Missouri 65026 and multiple client worksite locations within Miller and Camden counties, Missouri.

The employee will be responsible for operating commercial lawn equipment on residential and commercial property. The employee will be responsible for doing landscaping work including but not limited to bush trimming, mulch installation and sod installation. Additionally, the employee will be responsible for maintenance of the equipment.

Employees will work Monday-Sunday an average of 40 hrs/wk. Must be able to work up to 8 hours per shift within the hours of 8:00 am to 4:30 pm any day of the week, days off rotate, shifts vary. This job requires continuous movement, regularly bending, as well as lifting up to 50 pounds. No minimum education is required.

On-the-job training is provided by the employer. The employer will provide workers with all the tools, supplies, and equipment required to perform the job at no charge. The employer will provide daily transportation to and from their housing to the place of employment.

The wage is \$17.82 per hour. All deductions will be made from paychecks that are required by law. No other deductions will be made unless agreed upon. Overtime is not available. Wages will be paid bi-weekly on Wednesday, and the employer will use a single workweek as its standard for computing wages due.

This posting is being made in connection with an application for H-2B workers.

The employer will reimburse the H-2B worker in the first workweek for all visa, visa processing, border crossing, and other related fees, including those mandated by the government, incurred by the H-2B worker. If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, the employer will reimburse the worker for transportation and subsistence from the place of recruitment to the place of work. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will provide or pay for workers reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distance involved.

Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$16.28 per day during travel to a maximum of \$68.00 per day with receipts. Transportation (including one piece of luggage, meals, and to the extent necessary, lodging).

Housing is provided to the H-2B workers at \$120 per week, however, this is optional and is not a condition of employment. In the alternative, the employer will assist workers in securing suitable board/lodging within walking distance of the worksite.
